A simple provision such as the following may be all that is needed: "I hereby give, devise and bequeath _______ (specify a specific dollar amount, specific property or all or a percentage of your residuary estate) to the Mount Desert Summer Chorale, located in Mount Desert, Maine, to be used for its (specify either general charitable purposes or endowment)."

You can also plan a gift to the Chorale outside of a Will or Living Trust by naming the Chorale as a beneficiary to a retirement plan, IRA, bank or brokerage account or life insurance policy. These are easy and tax-efficient ways to give and support the Chorale and help ensure our ability to serve the community well into the future.

The Mount Desert Summer Chorale is recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a taxexempt 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, so that all gifts to the Chorale qualify for a tax deduction. The Chorale's federal tax identification number is 31-1781633.
